AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE COMPENSATION OF THE FLOOR LEADERS OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 3 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding after section 9A the fol-
3 lowing section:—

4 *Section 9B.* The compensation of the floor leaders
5 of each of the major parties in the senate and house
6 of representatives is hereby increased to an amount
7 equal to fifty per cent thereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January
2 first, nineteen hundred and forty-eight.
