AN ACT TO COMPEL RAILROADS TO ERECT FENCES OR OTHER

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

- 1 All railroads shall provide suitable safeguards on
- 2 all properties when such safeguards are deemed
- 3 necessary by properly constituted officers of cities or
- 4 towns.
