## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

---

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF A SPECIAL BONUS TO CERTAIN NEXT OF KIN OF RESIDENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH WHO WERE KILLED OR DIED WHILE SERVING IN THE ARMED FORCES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The treasurer of the commonwealth shall pay out  
2 of funds of the commonwealth appropriated therefor  
3 a special bonus of five hundred dollars to the widow  
4 and children or the father and mother of each resi-  
5 dent of the commonwealth who was killed or died in  
6 service while a member of the armed forces of the  
7 United States.
