By Mr. Conley of Lawrence, petition of Joseph T. Conley that needy persons be made eligible for receiving old age assistance upon reaching the age of sixty. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT MAKING NEEDY PERSONS ELIGIBLE FOR OLD AGE ASSISTANCE, SO CALLED, UPON REACHING THE AGE OF SIXTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 1 of chapter 118A of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chap-
3 ter 489 of the acts of 1943, is hereby amended by
4 striking out, in the second and in the twelfth lines,
5 the word "sixty-five" and inserting in place thereof,
6 in each instance, the word: — sixty.
