## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING INCREASES IN THE AMOUNTS OF PENSIONS AND RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES PAYABLE TO CERTAIN RETIRED EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BOSTON AND COUNTY OF SUFFOLK AND THEIR BENEFICIARIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Boston retirement board or  
2 other appropriate retiring authority, as the case  
3 may be, may increase by one hundred and twenty  
4 dollars per year, effective upon such date as the  
5 mayor of the city of Boston may fix, the present  
6 annual pension or retirement allowance of all former  
7 employees and of all beneficiaries of deceased em-  
8 ployees of the city of Boston and of the county of  
9 Suffolk who were retired prior to October first, nine-  
10 teen hundred and forty-six; provided, that such  
11 increase shall not be made in the case of a pension

12 or retirement allowance which is now nine hundred  
13 dollars per year or more; and provided, further, that  
14 no pension or retirement allowance shall be increased  
15 hereunder by an amount which will make the same  
16 exceed nine hundred dollars per year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance, during the current year, by vote of the  
3 city council of said city, subject to the provisions of  
4 its charter, but not otherwise.
