
By Mr. Parsons of Marblehead, petition of Everett R. Campbell and others (selectmen) for legislation relative to the reinstatement of Henry W. Reed in the employ of the town of Marblehead and in the retirement system of said town. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REINSTATEMENT OF HENRY W. REED IN THE EMPLOY OF THE TOWN OF AND REINSTATEMENT IN MEMBERSHIP IN THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE TOWN OF MARBLEHEAD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any provisions of chapter thirty-two of the General
2 Laws to the contrary notwithstanding, Henry W.
3 Reed, who was retired in October, nineteen hundred
4 and forty-six, may be reinstated in the position of
5 lineman in the employ of the electric light department
6 of the town of Marblehead. Upon such reinstatement,
7 he shall again become a member of the retirement
8 system of said town, with all the rights and obligations
9 entailed by such membership as if he had not been
10 retired; provided, that he shall receive no creditable
11 service from the date of his retirement to the date of
12 his reinstatement, and upon his subsequent retirement
13 the provisions of section eight (2) (b) relative to resto-
14 ration to service of members retired for disability shall
15 apply whether or not such subsequent retirement is
16 for disability.
