AN ACT RELATIVE TO INTEREST CHARGES ON TAXES  
ASSESSED IN THE TOWN OF MATTAPOISETT IN THE YEAR  
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FORTY-SEVEN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of  
2 law to the contrary, interest on property taxes assessed  
3 in the town of Mattapoissett in the year nineteen  
4 hundred and forty-seven shall be computed from the  
5 expiration of seventeen days from December twenty-  
6 fourth, nineteen hundred and forty-seven, the date on  
7 which tax bills were sent out, until the day of payment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
