AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PITTSFIELD TO SELL AND CONVEY CERTAIN PREMISES HELD BY SAID CITY FOR PARK, PLAYGROUND OR RECREATION PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Pittsfield is hereby au-
2 thorized to sell and convey, for a nominal considera-
3 tion, certain premises held by said city for park,
4 playground or recreation center purposes, which
5 premises were conveyed to it by Charles H. Wilson
6 by deed dated September fifteenth, nineteen hundred
7 and thirty-nine, and recorded in the Berkshire County
8 Middle District Registry of Deeds in Book 483,
9 page 416, and are more particularly described in
10 said deed as follows:— “Lots number 17 and 18 on
11 Plan of Taconic Property of James and E. H. Wilson,
12 Inc., which plan is recorded in the Berkshire County
13 Middle District Registry of Deeds, Book 417, pages
14 104 and 105”.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
