AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT AND STATUS OF  
JAMES H. MAHONEY AS A MEMBER OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT  
OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. James H. Mahoney, who was a member  
2 of the fire department of the city of Boston from  
3 November third, nineteen hundred and forty-three  
4 to January twenty-first, nineteen hundred and forty-  
5 eight, and who was injured in the performance of duty  
6 as a military substitute in said department, shall be  
7 deemed to be permanently appointed thereto without  
8 further examination and without being required to  
9 serve any probationary period.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
