AN ACT CLARIFYING THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF CERTAIN VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 56 of chapter 32 of the General
2 Laws, as amended by section 1 of chapter 453 of the
3 acts of 1947, is hereby further amended by adding
4 after the comma in line 13 the words:— “in the
5 aggregate,”

1 SECTION 2. Section 57 of said chapter, as amended
2 by section 2 of said chapter 453, is hereby further
3 amended by inserting after the first comma in line 3
4 the words:— “in the aggregate,”

1 SECTION 3. Section 58 of said chapter, as amended
2 by section 3 of chapter 514 of the acts of 1943, is
3 hereby further amended by adding after the first
4 comma in line 3 the words:— “in the aggregate,”
