AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PROVIDING ADDITIONAL BUILDINGS, EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums herein set forth, for the
2 purposes herein specified, are hereby appropriated
3 from the veterans' services fund, subject to the pro-
4 visions of law regulating the disbursement of public
5 funds and the approval thereof.
