AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TENURE OF OFFICE OF THE
HEAD GUARD AT THE CASTLE ISLAND TERMINAL OF THE
PORT OF BOSTON AUTHORITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The incumbent of the position of the
2 head guard at the Castle Island terminal of the Port
3 of Boston Authority, on the effective date of this
4 act shall be deemed to be permanently appointed
5 thereto without serving any probationary period, and
6 his tenure of employment shall be unlimited, subject,
7 however, to the civil service laws; provided, he
8 passes a qualifying examination to which he shall
9 be subjected by the division of civil service.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
