The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DEPOSIT BY THE STATE TREASURER OF PUBLIC MONEYS IN HIS POSSESSION.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would
2 tend to defeat its purpose, therefore it is hereby de-
3 clared to be an emergency law, necessary for the
4 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 34 of chapter 29 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 333 of the acts of
3 1936, is hereby amended by inserting after the word
4 "surplus" in the tenth line the words: — ; provided,
5 that said limit may be exceeded for the purpose of
6 the temporary deposit of receipts from tax collections
7 in a bank or trust company located on the same
8 premises as the office of the collection section of the
9 department of corporations and taxation.
