AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WOBURN TO PAY ANNUITIES TO THE WIDOW, HELEN T. KENNEY, AND MINOR CHILD, HELEN M. KENNEY, OF WILLIAM F. KENNEY, A POLICE OFFICER, NOW DECEASED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Woburn is hereby author-  
2 ized and empowered to pay annuities of twelve hun-  
3 dred dollars per year to the widow, Helen T. Kenney,  
4 and two hundred and sixty dollars to the minor child,  
5 Helen M. Kenney, of William F. Kenney, a police  
6 officer who died as a result of bodily injuries received  
7 while in the performance of duty, said annuities to  
8 be paid under the same terms and conditions provided  
9 by General Laws, Tercentenary Edition, chapter  
10 thirty-two, section eighty-nine, and amendments  
11 thereto.

1 SECTION 2. This act to go into effect upon accept-  
2 ance by the city council and the mayor of the city of  
3 Woburn.
