### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE HOLDING OF ADDITIONAL SESSIONS OF THE BOSTON JUVENILE COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 59 of chapter 218 of the  
2 General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary  
3 Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end the  
4 following paragraph: —

5 The justice of the said court, or in case of his death,  
6 illness, absence or incapacity, the senior special justice  
7 thereof, if in his opinion the public business so re-  
8 quires, may provide for additional sessions of the  
9 court.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July  
2 first in the current year.
