AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF DAMAGES CAUSED BY DEER AND MOOSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 83 of chapter 131 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in section 2 of chapter 599 of the acts of
3 1941, is hereby amended by adding at the end the
4 following paragraph: —

5 No damages shall be paid under this section to the
6 owner of damaged property if such owner has posted
7 on his land a notice stating that the hunting thereon
8 of deer is prohibited.
