RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL RELATIVE TO PROVIDING FOR FEES FOR EXECUTORS AND ADMINISTRATORS AND THEIR ATTORNEYS IN THE PROBATE OF ESTATES OF DECEASED PERSONS.

1     *Resolved*, That the judicial council be requested to  
2 investigate the subject matter of current house  
3 document numbered twelve hundred and eighty-two,  
4 relative to providing for fees for executors and ad-  
5 ministrators and their attorneys in the probate of  
6 estates of deceased persons, and to include its con-  
7 clusions and its recommendations, if any, in relation  
8 thereto, together with drafts of such legislation as  
9 may be necessary to give effect to the same, in its  
10 annual report for the year nineteen hundred and  
11 forty-eight.
