RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY THE
JUDICIAL COUNCIL RELATIVE TO AMENDING THE LAW
RELATING TO GAMING.

3 ment numbered four hundred and fifteen, relative to
4 amending the law relating to gaming, and to include
5 its conclusions and its recommendations, if any, in
6 relation thereto, together with drafts of such legisla-
7 tion as may be necessary to give effect to the same, in
8 its annual report for the year nineteen hundred and
9 forty-eight.
