AN ACT PERMITTING THE REGISTRATION AND OPERATION  
OR DRAWING OF CERTAIN TRAILERS USED EXCLUSIVELY  
FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF TOBACCO IN CONNECTION  
WITH THE GROWING AND PRODUCING THEREOF.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Section 19 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by chapter 341 of the acts of  
3 1946, is hereby further amended by adding at the end  
4 the following paragraph:—

5 Notwithstanding any of the foregoing provisions,  
6 trailers having a carrying capacity of not more than  
7 three thousand pounds, and heavy duty single-deck  
8 trailers having a carrying capacity of not more than six  
9 thousand pounds, used exclusively for the transporta-  
10 tion of tobacco in connection with the growing and  
11 producing thereof, may be registered and thereafter  
12 operated or drawn upon any way for a distance not  
13 exceeding five miles.
