AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE STATE HOUSING BOARD AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE VETERANS HOUSING PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum herein set forth, for the pur-
2 poses herein specified, is hereby appropriated from
3 the Veterans' Services Fund, subject to the provisions
4 of law regulating the disbursement of public funds
5 and the approval thereof.
