AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO PAY  
A SUM OF MONEY TO JAMES F. KEELEY OF SAID CITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 The city of Springfield, notwithstanding any statute  
2 or ordinance to the contrary, and subject to approval  
3 by vote of the city council of the city of Springfield,  
4 may pay to James F. Keeley of said city a sum not  
5 exceeding two hundred and ten dollars to reimburse him  
6 for money expended for counsel fees in connection with  
7 his appeal to the district court of Springfield from the  
8 action of the superintendent of public buildings of the  
9 city of Springfield in transferring or lowering him in  
10 rank from his employment as sanitary attendant to  
11 intermittent sanitary attendant in the department of  
12 public buildings, which appeal resulted in a reversal  
13 of the finding of the superintendent of public buildings  
14 and an order that he be reinstated to his position as  
15 sanitary attendant in the department of public  
16 buildings.
