AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE CITY OF LOWELL MAY APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF A LABOR-MANAGEMENT CITIZENS COMMITTEE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of Lowell may appropriate, in accordance
2 with the provisions of its charter, funds for the ex-
3 penses of maintaining a duly appointed labor-manage-
4 ment citizens committee; provided, however, that
5 the amount appropriated in any year under the
6 authority of this act shall not exceed one thousand
7 dollars.
