RESOLVE REQUESTING THE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE
OF THE PROBATE COURT TO MAKE A STUDY OF THE
PROBATE COURTS.

1 *Resolved*, That the administrative committee of the
2 probate court is hereby authorized and directed to
3 make an investigation and study of the subject matter
4 of current senate documents numbered 257 and 258
5 and house document 1943. Said committee shall
6 report to the general court the results of its investiga-
7 tions, and its recommendations, if any, together with
8 drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommen-
9 dations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of
10 the house of representatives on or before the first
11 Wednesday in December in the current year.
