AN ACT RELATIVE TO UNIFORMS FOR CERTAIN OFFICERS  
AND EMPLOYEES IN COUNTY PENAL INSTITUTIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 126 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by inserting after section 9 the following new sec-  
3 tion: —

4 *Section 9A.* Officers and employees of each county  
5 penal institution required to wear uniforms shall  
6 wear while on duty uniforms prescribed by the sheriff  
7 of the county, which shall be furnished at the expense  
8 of said county; provided, that expenditures for the  
9 same are authorized by the county commissioners.
