The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF CERTAIN ASSISTANT ATTORNEYS GENERAL AND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any assistant attorney general in office on the
2 effective date of this act who has had not less than
3 twenty years of service as such, and any county
4 commissioner then in office who has had not less than
5 twenty years of service as such and as the holder
6 of any elective or appointive public office in the
7 service of the commonwealth or any county, or both,
8 may, on or before December thirty-first, nineteen
9 hundred and forty-eight, become a member of the
10 state or county retirement system, as the case may
11 be, by depositing in the annuity savings fund of such
12 system the sum of five hundred dollars. Thereafter,
13 upon reaching the maximum age for his group, or, if
14 he has attained such maximum age, at such time

15 within two years from said effective date as he may
16 elect, he shall be retired and shall receive from the
17 commonwealth or county, as the case may be, a
18 retirement allowance or pension of twenty-four hun-
19 dred dollars per annum.
