RESOLUTIONS RELATIVE TO THE RECOGNITION OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL AND THE LIFTING OF THE EMBARGO ON ARMS TO PALESTINE.

Whereas, The general court of Massachusetts on February thirteenth, nineteen hundred and nineteen resolved that the national aspirations and historic claims of the Jewish people with regard to Palestine be recognized; and

Whereas, The general court on March twenty-ninth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two urged the government of the United States to recognize the status of the Jewish people in Palestine; and

Whereas, The government of the United States on May fourteenth, nineteen hundred and forty-eight recognized the State of Israel; therefore be it

Resolved, That the great and general court of Massachusetts hail the recognition of the state of Israel by the government of the United States; and be it further

Resolved, That the general court of the commonwealth favors and urges the lifting of the embargo on the shipment of arms to Palestine; and be it further

Resolved, That copies of these resolutions be forwarded forthwith by the secretary of the commonwealth to the president of the United States, to the chairman of the foreign affairs committee of the United States senate and to the members of Congress representing Massachusetts.
