HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, June 4, 1948.

The committee on Ways and Means, to whom were referred the Bill providing for the payment by the Commonwealth to cities and towns of a portion of the expense incurred by them for snow and ice removal and the sanding or other equivalent treatment of ways during the twelve months ending March thirty-first, nineteen hundred and forty-eight (printed in House, No. 1969), the Order relative to authorizing the committee on Highways and Motor Vehicles in the course of its study of highway projects throughout the Commonwealth to study the subject-matter of certain current Senate and House documents (House, No. 2078), the Order relative to authorizing the committee on Highways and Motor Vehicles in the course of a study of highway projects to consider the subject-matter of a petition authorizing the construction of a bridge over the Merrimack River in Lowell and of a state highway between Provincetown and Weymouth (House, No. 2232), the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 170) of Edmond J. Donlan for the payment by the Commonwealth to its municipalities in the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949, of a portion of the Highway Fund to be expended by them for local highway purposes, the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 290) of Edmond J. Donlan that one half of the cost of snow removal from public ways be paid from the Highway Fund and the remaining half shall be paid by cities and towns, and the peti-

tion (accompanied by bill, House, No. 373) of Edmond J. Donlan for a fair and proportionate distribution of the Highway Fund among the cities and towns to be expended by them for local highway purposes, report that the same ought to be adopted in the form of a new draft herewith submitted (House, No. 2364).
