RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION OF A STATUE IN COMMEMORATION OF THE LATE GENERAL GEORGE S. PATTON, JR.

1 *Resolved*, That the metropolitan district commis-
2 sion is hereby authorized and directed to erect, at
3 such location on the Storrow Memorial Embankment
4 in the vicinity of the Hatch Shell in the city of Boston
5 as it may determine a statue, substantially like the
6 model made under authority of chapter forty-one of
7 the resolves of nineteen hundred and forty-seven, in
8 commemoration of the late General George S. Patton,
9 Jr. Said commission may request of the art com-
10 mission for the commonwealth its opinion of the
11 proposed statue and may consider such suggestions
12 and recommendations as said art commission may
13 make. For the services of a sculptor in making such
14 memorial, and of a landscape architect for landscap-
15 ing, and for any other expenses incidental or neces-
16 sary to the erection of such memorial, said metro-
17 politan district commission may expend such sums
18 as may be appropriated therefor.
