Ordered, That a special committee, consisting of seven members of the House of Representatives to be designated by the speaker thereof, is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject matter of current Senate Document numbered five hundred and sixty-nine, relative to the regulation of midget automobile racing, with a view to suggesting such legislation as it may deem necessary or advisable in relation to said subject matter. Said committee may expend for services and expenses such sums, not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars, as may be appropriated therefor.
