HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, June 18, 1948.

Amendments, adopted by the House, on motion of Mr. Serino of Cambridge, to the engrossed Bill relating to non-profit hospital service corporations (see House bill printed in Senate, No. 611) by striking out all after the title and inserting in place thereof the following:—

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, con-
2 sisting of one member of the senate to be designated
3 by the president thereof, two members of the house
4 of representatives to be designated by the speaker
5 thereof, and two persons to be appointed by the
6 governor, is hereby established to make an investiga-
7 tion and study of the subject matter of current senate
8 document numbered six hundred and eleven, relating
9 to non-profit hospital service corporations. Said com-
10 mission shall be provided with quarters in the state
11 house or elsewhere, may hold public hearings and may
12 expend for clerical and other services such sums as
13 may be appropriated therefor. Said commission shall
14 report to the general court the results of its investiga-
15 tion and study, and its recommendations, if any,
16 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
17 such recommendations into effect, by filing the same
18 with the clerk of the house of representatives not later
19 than the first Wednesday of December in the current

20 year,—and by striking out the title and inserting in
21 place thereof the following:— Resolve providing for
22 the Establishment of a Special Commission to make
23 an Investigation and Study relative to Non-Profit
24 Hospital Service Corporations.
