AN ACT REQUIRING ADDITIONAL WARNING SIGNS WHEN  
PUBLIC WAYS ARE UNDER CONSTRUCTION OR REPAIR  
OR WHEN BEING OILED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 84 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by inserting after section 6, as appearing in the Ter-  
3 centenary Edition, the following section:— *Section*  
4 *6A.* A person who is in charge of any public way  
5 which is under construction or repair, or upon which  
6 tar, oil or similar substance is being spread, shall, in  
7 addition to any other warning, cause a sign or warning  
8 of such repair or oiling to be posted at the nearest in-  
9 tersection on either side of the place where such work  
10 is being done.
