

To accompany the petition of Jacob Kaufman for legislation to extend to certain students of medicine at the College of Physicians and Surgeons the privilege of becoming registered as qualified physicians. Public Health.

AN ACT EXTENDING TO CERTAIN STUDENTS OF MEDICINE AT THE COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS AND SURGEONS THE PRIVILEGE OF BECOMING REGISTERED AS QUALIFIED PHYSICIANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 364 of the acts of 1946 is hereby amended
2 by adding at the end the following section:—
3 *Section 6.* Notwithstanding any contrary provi-
4 sion of law, any person who was a student at said
5 college prior to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and
6 forty-six, and who shall receive a degree of doctor of
7 medicine therefrom prior to June thirtieth, nineteen
8 hundred and forty-nine, shall be eligible to be an
9 applicant for registration as a qualified physician,
10 shall be examined for such registration by the board
11 of registration in medicine, and shall be subject to
12 and have the benefit of all pertinent provisions of
13 law relative to such eligibility and examination.
