To accompany the petition of Willard A. Ormsbee for legislation to increase the term of office of the Director of Registration in the Department of Civil Service and Registration. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT INCREASING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF REGISTRATION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL SERVICE AND REGISTRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 13 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 13 of chap-
3 ter 591 of the acts of 1946, is hereby further amended
4 by striking out, in the last line the word "two" and
5 inserting in place thereof the word: — five, — so as to
6 read as follows: — *Section 8.* The division of registra-
7 tion shall be under the supervision of a director, to
8 be known as the director of registration, at such
9 salary, not exceeding thirty-four hundred dollars, as
10 the governor and council may determine. Upon the
11 expiration of the term of office of a director, his suc-
12 cessor shall be appointed by the governor, with the
13 advice and consent of the council, for not exceeding
14 five years.

1 SECTION 2. The tenure of office of the director of
2 the division of registration in the department of civil
3 service and registration in office on the effective
4 date of this act shall continue until the expiration of
5 five years from the date of his most recent appoint-
6 ment.
