## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION BY THE COMMONWEALTH FOR ARMORY PURPOSES OF A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN THE CITY OF LYNN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subject to the approval of the governor and council  
2 the armory commissioners are hereby authorized and  
3 directed to acquire, for the purpose of increasing the  
4 facilities of the state armory in the city of Lynn, a  
5 parcel of land in said city bounded and described as  
6 follows:— Beginning at a stone monument on South  
7 Common street, thence running easterly forty-five  
8 and thirty-four one hundredths (45.34) feet to Pleas-  
9 ant street; thence running southeasterly on said  
10 Pleasant street one hundred thirty and nineteen one  
11 hundredths (130.19) feet to land of the common-  
12 wealth; thence running southwesterly by said land of  
13 the commonwealth one hundred fifty-one and sixty-  
14 eight one hundredths (151.68) feet; thence turning

15 and running northwesterly one hundred ninety-four  
16 and thirty-five one hundredths (194.35) feet to said  
17 South Common street and the point of beginning, and  
18 containing approximately thirteen thousand seven  
19 hundred and ninety-four square feet.

20 For said purposes the armory commissioners may  
21 expend such sum, not exceeding \_\_\_\_\_ dol-  
22 lars, as may be appropriated therefor.
