To accompany the petition of John D. Mackay for legislation relative to the payment of compensation to the executive clerk to the Chief Justice of the Superior Court for certain duties performed after his retirement. The Judiciary.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXECUTIVE CLERK TO THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 28 of chapter 212 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the
3 following paragraph: —

4 For performing duties as defined by said chief
5 justice the said executive clerk after having been re-
6 tired shall, notwithstanding the provisions of section
7 ninety-one of chapter thirty-two or any other law, be
8 entitled to receive compensation from the common-
9 wealth; provided, that there shall be deducted there-
10 from an amount equal to the retirement allowance or
11 pension received by him, during his employment.
