To accompany the petition of Bernard J. Riley and Joseph A. Melley that provision be made for the furnishing at the Soldiers' Home in Massachusetts of medicine, without charge, to certain war veterans. Military Affairs and Public Safety.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE FURNISHING AT THE SOLDIERS' HOME IN MASSACHUSETTS OF MEDICINE, WITHOUT CHARGE, TO WAR VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The trustees of the Soldiers' Home in Massachusetts
2 are hereby authorized and directed to furnish medi-
3 cine at said home, without charge, to war veterans,
4 and said trustees shall no longer continue the practice
5 of furnishing prescriptions for medicine and making
6 it necessary that war veterans have such prescriptions
7 filled at drug stores at their own expense.
