An Act providing for the issuing of licenses as Journeyman plumbers to persons who have served as such for twenty-five years or more.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 142 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after section 4, as amended, the following
- 3 section: -
- 4 Section 4A. Notwithstanding the provisions of
- 5 section four, the examiners shall issue a license or
- 6 certificate of registration upon application therefor to
- 7 any person who has been a journeyman plumber for
- 8 twenty-five years or more, without examination but
- 9 upon payment of the required fee.
