AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUING OF LICENSES AS  
JOURNEYMAN PLUMBERS TO PERSONS WHO HAVE SERVED  
AS SUCH FOR TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OR MORE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 142 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by inserting after section 4, as amended, the following  
3 section: —

4 *Section 4A.* Notwithstanding the provisions of  
5 section four, the examiners shall issue a license or  
6 certificate of registration upon application therefor to  
7 any person who has been a journeyman plumber for  
8 twenty-five years or more, without examination but  
9 upon payment of the required fee.
