AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CIVIL SERVICE RIGHTS OF CERTAIN PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 43 the following new sec-
3 tion:—

4 *Section 43A.* Any person permanently appointed
5 to a position classified under this chapter who is
6 appointed or promoted to a position in the same
7 division or department not subject to this chapter,
8 shall, upon ceasing to hold said unclassified office or
9 position, be forthwith reinstated to the same or a
10 similar position in the classified service as that form-
11 erly held by him prior to such appointment or pro-
12 motion.
