AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DECISIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 152 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is
3 hereby amended by striking out in the second sentence
4 the words "together with a statement of the evidence"
5 and by adding at the end of the second sentence the
6 following:— within ten days after the date of the
7 hearing, — and by inserting at the end thereof the
8 following new sentence:— A statement of the evi-
9 dence shall be prepared and furnished each party
10 without cost by the department if a claim for review
11 is filed under section ten; if no claim for review is
12 filed, any party may be entitled to such statement of
13 the evidence upon payment of a reasonable fee to
14 the department.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
