## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT EXTENDING TO THE POLISH-AMERICAN VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II INC. THE BENEFITS OF CERTAIN LAWS AFFECTING VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 49 of chapter 33 of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 468  
3 of the acts of 1947, is hereby further amended by  
4 inserting after the words "U. S. A." in line 47 the  
5 words: — , Polish-American Veterans of World War  
6 II Inc.

The Constitution of Massachusetts

As amended to the 27th of September, 1919

Article I. The Legislature shall consist of a Senate and a House of Representatives.

Article II. The Executive Power shall be vested in the Governor and Council.

Article III. The Judicial Power shall be vested in a Supreme Judicial Court, and such other Courts as the Legislature may establish.

Article IV. The Militia shall be so organized and regulated as to be ready for service in the defence of the Commonwealth.
