

SENATE No. 307

To accompany the petition of Michael H. Condon for legislation to increase the minimum pension provided for certain retired public school teachers. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT TO INCREASE TO SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS THE MINIMUM PENSION PROVIDED FOR CERTAIN RETIRED PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 From June first, nineteen hundred and forty-eight,
2 members of the Teachers' Retirement Association
3 retired under section ten of chapter thirty-two of the
4 General Laws, as in effect on December thirty-first,
5 nineteen hundred and forty-five, shall receive a retire-
6 ment allowance at the annual rate which they would
7 have received if, at the time of their retirement, the
8 minimum pension under paragraphs (4), (5), and (10)
9 of said section had been the annual amount of pension
10 which, when added to the annual amount which would
11 have been paid from the annuity fund if the member
12 had chosen an annuity under paragraph (3) (a) of said
13 section, would have provided a retirement allowance
14 of seven hundred and fifty dollars.
