

SENATE No. 335

To accompany the petition of Joseph A. Melley and Jeremiah Kamens that service performed as a reserve member of a police department be counted as regular service for the purpose of retirement. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT FOR THE PURPOSE OF RETIREMENT SERVICE PERFORMED AS A RESERVE MEMBER OF A POLICE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE COUNTED AS REGULAR SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 83A of chapter 32 of the General Laws,
2 inserted by section 3 of chapter 576 of the acts of
3 1946, is hereby amended by adding at the end of
4 paragraph (c) the following sentence:—For the
5 purpose of retirement service performed as a reserve
6 officer in said department shall be counted as service
7 performed as a regular member.
