AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WINCHESTER TO SELL  
CERTAIN LAND HELD BY IT FOR PARK PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Winchester is hereby au-  
2 thorized to sell and convey a certain parcel of land  
3 held by it for park purposes and no longer needed for  
4 park purposes, the land being a triangular parcel of  
5 land situated in said Winchester bounded south-  
6 easterly by other land of the town of Winchester 638  
7 feet more or less; southwesterly by land of Boston  
8 and Maine Railroad, Woburn Branch, 180 feet; and  
9 northwesterly by land of Beggs and Cobb 530.99 feet  
10 containing 43,000 square feet more or less, being all  
11 of said measurements more or less, and being the same  
12 parcel which is marked "43,000 square feet" on a  
13 "Plan of Land, Town of Winchester — Beggs and Cobb,  
14 Swanton Street, Winchester, Mass., November, 1947,  
15 Parker Holbrook, Town Engineer."

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance by a majority of the town meeting members  
3 of the town of Winchester present and voting thereon  
4 at a meeting called for the purpose.
