### RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF THE TOWN OF CHESTER.

1 *Resolved*, That after an appropriation has been  
2 made therefor, there shall be allowed and paid out  
3 of the treasury of the commonwealth to the town of  
4 Chester an amount not exceeding the sum of one  
5 thousand dollars, to reimburse said town for expenses  
6 incurred by it in fighting forest fires in the reservation  
7 in said town in nineteen hundred and forty-seven.
