RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SURVEY AND STUDY BY THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO STUDY AND REVISE THE LAWS RELATING TO PUBLIC WELFARE.

1 *Resolved*, That the special unpaid commission es-  
2 tablished by chapter fifty-seven of the resolves of  
3 nineteen hundred and forty-seven to make a survey  
4 and study of the laws of the commonwealth relating  
5 to public welfare shall, in making said survey and  
6 study, consider the subject matter of current senate  
7 document numbered sixty-one, relative to providing  
8 aid for persons who are permanently disabled or  
9 chronically sick.
