AN ACT PLACING THE OFFICE OF VETERANS' AGENT OF
THE TOWN OF MILLBURY UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE
LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The office of Veterans' Agent of the
2 town of Millbury shall, upon the effective date of
3 this act, become subject to the civil service laws, and
4 the rules and regulations made thereunder, and the
5 tenure of office of any subsequent incumbent of said
6 office shall be unlimited, subject, however, to said civil
7 service laws. The incumbent of said office on said
8 effective date shall be subjected to a non-competitive
9 qualifying examination for said office by the division
10 of civil service of the department of civil service and
11 registration. If said incumbent passes said examina-
12 tion, he shall be certified for said office and shall be
13 deemed to be permanently appointed thereto without
14 serving any probationary period, and his tenure of

15 office shall be unlimited, subject, however, to the pro-
16 visions of said laws. If said incumbent does not pass
17 such non-competitive qualifying examination, he may
18 continue to serve in said office, but shall not be sub-
19 ject to the provisions of said laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
