AN ACT PLACING THE OFFICE OF SENIOR LEGAL ASSISTANT
OF THE APPELLATE TAX BOARD UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE
LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The person holding the office of senior legal assistant
2 of the appellate tax board shall, upon the effective
3 date of this act, become subject to the civil service
4 laws and rules, and his tenure of office shall be un-
5 limited, subject, however, to said laws, but he shall
6 be subjected by the division of civil service to a non-
7 competitive qualifying examination, and if he passes
8 said examination he shall be certified for said office
9 and shall be deemed to be permanently appointed
10 thereto without being required to serve any proba-
11 tionary period.
