The committee on Ways and Means, to whom was committed the House Bill changing the location of the Massachusetts Maritime Academy to the State pier on the Cape Cod Canal, placing in the Board of Commissioners of said academy the control of said pier, and authorizing said board to acquire property adjoining said pier for the purposes of said academy (House, No. 1218), report recommending that the same ought to pass with an amendment substituting a new draft entitled "An Act authorizing the use of the State Pier on the Cape Cod Canal for the purposes of the Massachusetts Maritime Academy, placing in the board of commissioners of said academy the control of said pier while so used, and authorizing said board to acquire property adjoining said pier for said purposes" (Senate, No. 599).

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE STATE PIER ON THE CAPE COD CANAL FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE MASSACHUSETTS MARITIME ACADEMY, PLACING IN THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF SAID ACADEMY THE CONTROL OF SAID PIER WHILE SO USED, AND AUTHORIZING SAID BOARD TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY ADJOINING SAID PIER FOR SAID PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of commissioners of the
2 Massachusetts Maritime Academy is hereby author-
3 ized to use the state pier on the Cape Cod canal in
4 Buzzards bay, in addition to the property formerly
5 used for the purposes of the state teachers college at
6 Barnstable, in carrying out the duties imposed upon it
7 by law. Said board shall have control of said state
8 pier property while it is used for the purpose aforesaid.

1 SECTION 2. Said board, on behalf of the common-
2 wealth, may take by eminent domain, or acquire by
3 purchase or otherwise, so much of the property ad-
4 joining said state pier property as may be approved
5 by the governor and council. The property acquired
6 under the authority of this section shall also be under

7 the control of said board and shall be used for drill,
8 athletic and other purposes of said academy.

1 SECTION 3. Chapter three hundred and forty-seven
2 of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-six is hereby
3 repealed.
