The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN PROBATION OFFICERS OF THE DISTRICT COURTS IN SUFFOLK COUNTY, OTHER THAN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON, AND OF THE BOSTON JUVENILE COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 276 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after section 83B the
3 following four sections: —

4 *Section 83C.* The classification under section
5 eighty-three of every person serving as a probation
6 officer or a chief probation officer on June twenty-
7 fourth, nineteen hundred and forty-seven in a dis-
8 trict court in the county of Suffolk, other than the
9 municipal court of the city of Boston, or in the Boston
10 juvenile court shall be completed not later than
11 July first in the year nineteen hundred and forty-
12 eight. If any such classification is completed after
13 said July first, it shall be effective as of said July first.

14 *Section 83D.* Every person serving as a probation
15 officer or a chief probation officer on June twenty-
16 fourth, nineteen hundred and forty-seven in a district
17 court in the county of Suffolk, other than the municipal
18 court of the city of Boston, or in the Boston juvenile
19 court shall, effective July first in the year nineteen
20 hundred and forty-eight, be paid as follows: (a) every
21 such person with respect to whom it shall be deter-
22 mined as hereinafter provided that, if section eighty-
23 three and the minimum qualifications established
24 thereunder had been in force on July first, nineteen
25 hundred and forty-five and a classification had then
26 been made thereunder, he would on said date have
27 been classified in the rank held by him on July first
28 in the year nineteen hundred and forty-eight, the
29 maximum salary of his class; (b) every such person
30 not coming under (a) with respect to whom it shall
31 be so determined that if section eighty-three and
32 the minimum qualifications established thereunder
33 had been in force on July first, nineteen hundred and
34 forty-six and a classification had then been made
35 thereunder, he would on said date have been classified
36 in the rank held by him on July first in the year nine-
37 teen hundred and forty-eight, the maximum salary of
38 his class less two hundred dollars; and (c) every such
39 person not coming under either (a) or (b) with respect
40 to whom it shall be so determined that if the classifi-
41 cation provided for by section eighty-three had been
42 completed on or before July first, nineteen hundred
43 and forty-seven, he would on said date have been
44 classified in the rank held by him on July first in the
45 year nineteen hundred and forty-eight, the maximum
46 salary of his class less four hundred dollars. Persons
47 coming under (b) shall receive the annual increase pro-

48 vided for by section eighty-three on July first, nine-
49 teen hundred and forty-nine; and persons coming
50 under (c) shall receive one such increase on said date
51 and another such increase on July first, nineteen hun-
52 dred and fifty. The presiding justice of each of the
53 district courts in the county of Suffolk, other than
54 the municipal court of the city of Boston, and of the
55 Boston juvenile court, subject to the approval of the
56 justices of the municipal court of the city of Boston
57 after consultation with the board of probation, shall
58 make the determinations necessary to effectuate the
59 purposes of this section.

60 *Section 83E.* Any person serving as a probation
61 officer or a chief probation officer on June twenty-
62 fourth, nineteen hundred and forty-seven in a district
63 court in the county of Suffolk, other than the municipi-
64 pal court of the city of Boston, or in the Boston juve-
65 nile court, who has been or shall be classified under
66 section eighty-three in a class the maximum salary for
67 which is lower than his salary on June twenty-fourth,
68 nineteen hundred and forty-seven, shall be paid under
69 section eighty-three at the same rate as on June
70 twenty-fourth, nineteen hundred and forty-seven.

71 *Section 83F.* Nothing in this act shall be construed
72 to affect the provision in section eighty-three relative
73 to probation officers who are gainfully employed in
74 addition to their duties as probation officers. Any
75 probation officer who has served satisfactorily as a full
76 time probation officer for more than fifteen years may
77 be classified as a probation supervisor whether or not
78 he is chiefly engaged in supervising the work of other
79 probation officers.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
